



DRESS CODE POLICY

The Dress Code Policy aims to maintain reasonable and appropriate standards at all Golf Québec competitions. All Golf Québec players and caddies must adhere to the Golf Québec dress code. The dress code applies during all official practice rounds and competition rounds, as well as whenever the player or caddie is on the host venue's course.

Additional dress code restrictions imposed by the host venue are in addition to Golf Québec's requirements.

The committee reserves the right to determine whether an outfit is appropriate or not. Players who violate the Dress Code Policy will not be permitted to start their round, or if the violation is discovered after play has begun, the player or caddie must promptly comply.

Men – Boys

- Golf Bermuda shorts are permitted.
- Golf shirts must have a collar and must be tucked in unless specifically designed to be worn untucked, mock neck collars are allowed.
- Cargo-style pants or shorts (with exterior pockets), safari-style, or rugby-style attire is prohibited.
- Jeans of any colour, workout clothing, and tank tops are also prohibited.
- Caps or visors must not be worn backwards or tilted upward and must be removed indoors unless permitted by the host venue.

Women – Girls

- Dresses, skirts, pants, capris, Bermuda shorts, and shorts are permitted.
- Shirts, with or without a collar, may be worn with or without sleeves.
- Shirts may be worn untucked but must be long enough to cover the abdomen.
- Jeans of any colour, workout clothing, and tank tops are also prohibited.
- Caps or visors must not be worn backwards or tilted upward and must be removed indoors unless permitted by the host venue.

Footwear

Golf shoes with metal spikes are prohibited during competition rounds and official practice rounds.

Regarding footwear, caddies are subject to the same restrictions as players, but smooth-soled shoes or running shoes are preferred.

Closed-toe shoes are always mandatory when caddying, playing or practicing on the competition grounds.

Logos and Branding

Players and caddies are prohibited from displaying or wearing clothing, accessories, or equipment with logos or brands that Golf Quebec considers, at its sole discretion, to be:

- Detrimental to Golf Quebec
- Likely to be interpreted as insulting, offensive, hateful, obscene, or discriminatory

The display of logos and branding in the following categories is also prohibited:

- Tobacco or cannabis products.
- Illegal or prohibited substances.
- Firearms or other weapons.
- Adult-only products and services.
- Alcohol products.
- Gambling and betting services, unless the players and caddies are of legal age to participate in these activities

Any violation of this policy may result in disqualification.
