NOTES

For all tournaments, the same points will be allocated to all golfers tied for a specific rank.

In general, the committee may add / delete events throughout the 2019 golf season.

A maximum of eight (8) tournaments from April 1, 2019, to October 15, 2019, will count for points on the OOM. A player may play in more than eight (8) events on the tournament listing but only the best eight (8) events will count for points.

Please note that the OOM ranking will be considered final as of October 20, 2019. Any corrections (regardless of fault) will not be made after that date.

For any tournament (stroke play only): if there is a cut in the event, all players missing that cut will get 5% of the winner's share. All players making the cut will be guaranteed a minimum of the last place of the cut points in the Points Distribution Chart.

Triple Crown: the three tournaments that will be used to determine the triple crown are the Duke of Kent, the Alexander of Tunis and the Provincial Amateur Championship. The points mentioned above in the tournament listing will be given to each players in the 3 tournaments.

NCAA : for all NCAA tournaments, only the stroke-play portion of the event will be used to award points.

U.S. Amateur: only the match play chart for 64 players will be used to award points to players for that tournament.

U.S. Amateur - Regional Qualifying: points will be awarded only to those players that played in a regional qualifying event. Qualifying points will not be awarded to players who receive an exemption (of any kind) into a tournament. **It is the players' responsibility to tell Golf Québec that they have participated in a regional qualifying round, so that Golf Québec can award points accordingly.**
