GENERAL INFORMATION

Every athlete participating in the Sports-études golf program presented by adidas is invited to attend the annual training camp to be held from March 14 to 22, 2025.

Golf Québec prepared a package including transportation, accommodation, golf activities, and the supervision of athletes by a team of coaches. We are also providing you with a check list, at the end of this Guide, to make sure that your children get everything they need in their suitcases.

During their stay, participating athletes will play at the Magnolia Greens (six days) in the splendid area of Wilmington, North Carolina. They will reside at the TownePlace Suites by Marriott in Wilmington. Breakfasts are included.

All athletes will be paired prior to the trip and, upon arrival at the hotel, they will be assigned to a specific room. Coaches will supervise all athletes at all time. The curfew will be enforced at 10 p.m. and rooms will be systematically checked every night.

If some parents happen to be in North Carolina, they will only be allowed to visit their children in the evening. During the training camp, athletes will not be authorized to leave the hotel even if they are with their parents. Those who would like to communicate with their children can call the TownePlace Suites by Marriott, in the evening, or ask for our coach Daniel Langevin's room. Training

All athletes will train daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (golf round and practice range) based on the following preliminary schedule (the final schedule and golf clubs will be confirmed before leaving the province of Québec):

Magnolia Greens Golf Plantation Golf Club

Host to the 1998 and 1999 PGA Tour qualifiers, the Magnolia Greens Golf Plantation features 27 holes. Built in 1998 and designed by Tom Jackson, the Magnolia Greens Golf Plantation is considered by many golf professionals, from Québec and the United States, as the best golf club in North Carolina.

Travelling to the United States

Canadian citizens traveling to the U.S. by land, sea or air must **present a valid Canadian passport**. If you haven't already done so, order a passport today by visiting the [Government of Canada website](#). Without a passport, it will be impossible to participate in the training camp.

A copy of the passport must be provided to Golf Québec by e-mail no later than **February 5, 2025**. It is not necessary to provide Golf Québec with the athlete's original identification papers. However, they must be in the athlete's possession on the bus. Coaches will check these documents upon boarding for departures from Québec, on the way out, and from North Carolina on the way back.

Travelling Authorization

To pass through U.S. customs unhindered, all parents must provide Golf Québec with the *Travelling Authorization* form that you will find on page 5, duly completed, and proof that your child is covered by travel insurance with a complete medical plan for the duration of the stay in the United States. The form and insurance proof must be received by Golf Québec no later than **February 5, 2025**.

Participation Fees

The participation fees for this training camp is **\$2,150**, to be paid by credit card in two (2) installments:

- First payment on **February 1, 2025**, in the amount of \$1,075;
- Second payment on **March 1, 2025**, in the amount of \$1,075.

All fees must be paid before departure on March 14, 2025.

These fees include transportation, hotel accommodations and breakfasts, all golf activities, as well as athlete monitoring and supervision by the coaching team. Student-athletes will be from two (2) to four (4) per room.

Except for breakfasts, all meals and snacks are at the athletes' expense (**please plan for an amount of approximately US\$50 per day**). Please note that the costs obtained from service providers for this training camp are group rates. The withdrawal of an athlete will not reduce the overall costs of this training camp.

* Courses may be modified if necessary (condition, accessibility, general state, etc.). Visited golf clubs will be confirmed prior to departure.

Then, it will be important to provide us with the following documents by e-mail **no later than February 5, 2025**:

- Travelling authorization
- Parental authorization
- Copy of valid passport

Athletes whose parents are not in good financial standing with Golf Québec will have their participation in the training camp outside Québec cancelled.

Confirmation of participation

Important: **Limited places (48 places)**

An e-mail will be sent to you during the week of January 6, 2025, to finalize your online registration on the Golf Genius website (no online registration can be done before).

Registration deadline: **January 31, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.**

Your child's participation will be confirmed by Golf Québec afterwards.

Special note:

Parents present during that week will not be allowed to "attend or be present" at the athletes' training sites.

During this camp, all athletes must use the same common transportation to and from the hotel and various training sites.

If parents wish to attend the two (2) days of competition, on Thursday and Friday, they must fully comply, with Golf Québec's Spectator Code of Conduct Policy (PDF document).

I have also read the Code of ethics and discussed it with my child. In the event of a serious breach of the Code of ethics, I authorize Golf Québec or the Head Coach to take all necessary measures to bring my child home as directly and safely as possible. I agree to reimburse Golf Québec for all costs incurred in bringing my child home in the event of a serious breach of the code of ethics or in the event of illness.

I also understand that if any damage is caused by my child to the bus or to the golf and/or hotel facilities, I will assume responsibility for reimbursing them, including a \$25 administration fee.

Telephone calls made by my child from the hotel room will also be billed to me by Golf Québec, including a \$25 administration fee.

Return:

The group will leave Wilmington late on Friday, March 21, 2025, with arrival scheduled for Saturday, March 22. Meeting points will be the same as for the departure.

Coaches will also notify all athletes to contact their parents prior to departure from North Carolina. Michèle Raymond of Golf Québec will be informed by the coaches of any changes to the schedule.

It should be noted that the return to class and training will take place during the week of March 24 according to the instructions of the Supervising Coach of each structure.

Additional travel information:

Participants will travel in a bus equipped with air conditioning and an audio system. A vehicle will be available on site for emergency transportation. Travel time is estimated at 18 hours (departure from Montréal). Stops are planned for meals and to loosen muscles. The coaching team will accompany the athletes on the bus. Head Coach Daniel Langevin will already be on site in North Carolina to oversee preparations for the group's arrival. Please note that no parents are allowed on the bus, either on the outward or return journey.
