NOTES

For all tournaments, the same points will be allocated to all golfers tied for a specific rank.

In general, the committee may add / delete events throughout the 2020 golf season.

A maximum of six (6) tournaments from April 1, 2020 to October 15, 2020 will count for points on the OOM. A player may play in more than six (6) events on the tournament listing but only the best six (6) events will count for points.

Please note that the OOM ranking will be considered final as of October 20, 2020. Any corrections (regardless of fault) will not be made after that date.

For any tournament (stroke-play only): if there is a cut in the event, all players missing that cut will get 5 % of the winners share. All players making the cut will be guaranteed a minimum of the last place of the cut points in the Points Distribution Chart.

For any tournament (stroke-play followed by Match-Play) : all players that failed to qualify for the match-play portion will receive points. The points taken will be the category of points right after the last place points of the match-play points. Ex: R32 gives 2 000 points, the players would receive points based on the 1 000 points list. The first players to miss the match-play would be awarded the points of 1st place on the 1 000 points list and so on.

Jocelyne Bourassa Series: the Debbie Savoy Morel Cup and the Women's Provincial Amateur Championship are the two events that will count. The same number of points will be allocated to the winner as identified in the tournament listing above.

U.S. Women's Amateur: only the match-play chart for 64 players will be used to award points to players for that tournament.

U.S. Women's Amateur - Regional Qualifying : points will be awarded only to those players that played in a regional qualifying event. Qualifying points will not be awarded to players who receive an exemption (of any kind) into a tournament. **It is the players' responsibility to tell Golf Québec that they have participated in a regional qualifying round, so that Golf Québec can award points accordingly.**
