



## DRESS CODE

The purpose of the Dress Code to ensure reasonable and appropriate standards are maintained at all Golf Québec competitions. All players and caddies must adhere to the Golf Québec dress code. The Dress Code is in effect during all official practice and tournament rounds; and any time the player or caddie is on the host golf course property.

The Golf Québec Dress Code is in effect at all competitions in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the host facility.

The Tournament Committee will review questionable attire. Players in violation of the Dress Code will not be allowed to tee off or, if the violation is discovered once play has begun, the competitor or caddie must rectify without undue delay.

### Men – Boys

- Golf shorts are permitted.
- Golf shirts must have collars and must be tucked in unless specifically tailored for wearing untucked; mock necks are permitted;
- Cargo, safari, rugby or jogging style pants are prohibited;
- Jeans, no matter the colour, exercise clothing and sleeveless shirts are prohibited.

Hats or visors must not be worn upwards or facing backwards and must be taken off when inside the buildings at a golf club.

### Women – Girls

- Dresses, skirts, pants, capris, or golf shorts are permitted;
- Shirts with or without collars may be worn with or without sleeves. Shoulders must be covered;
- Shirts may be worn untucked but must be long enough to cover the abdomen;
- Jeans, no matter the colour, exercise clothing and tank tops are prohibited.

### Footwear – applies to both players and caddies

Wearing golf shoes is allowed during the competition rounds, including official practice rounds.

At all times footwear is to be worn when a player is on the host club property.

**Note: Penalty for breach of this policy may result in disqualification.**
