

## REFEREE'S CODE OF CONDUCT

*This is a translation of the original French document. In case of divergence of interpretation, the French text shall prevail over the English text.*



In addition to the [Policy on the Protection of Integrity in Sports](#), adopted on February 9, 2021, and its codes of conduct.

No competition conducted by the Québec Golf Federation (“Golf Québec”) can be held in a satisfactory manner without the attendance of referees. Adequate rulings are enabling everyone’s enjoyment of the game and protect participants. An efficient and competent referee must:

- a) Know the rules and their interpretation;
- b) Comply with the rules set out;
- c) Apply the rules and regulation with objectivity and impartiality, fairly, and good judgment;
- d) Communicate respectfully with participants;
- e) Protect the integrity of the competition and security of participants;
- f) Be open to criticism;
- g) Maintain the required level of competency;
- h) Share his/her knowledge and expertise with his/her colleagues;
- i) Avoid being overly assertive to the disadvantage of participants.
