Audrey Paradis joins Wagner College

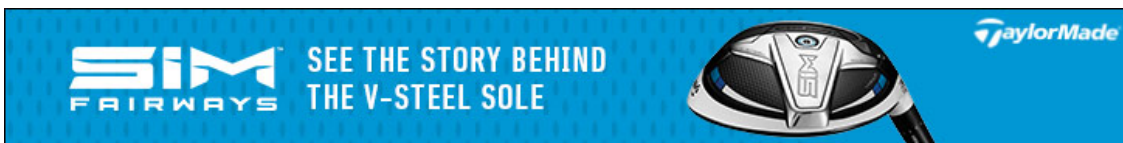
